

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL MEMBERS

FEE INFORMATION

- Cheques/Money Orders should be payable to *Loyalist Winter Club*.
- There will be a \$35.00 charge for any N.S.F. cheque.
- There will be no refunds after November 1, 2009. Any pullouts prior to this date will be subject to a \$25.00 administration charge. Medical reasons will be the exception. All refunds will be pro-rated.
- A 50% deposit is payable at registration. The remainder may be paid in post-dated cheque(s), also to accompany the application form, with all fees paid by November 1, 2009.
- Loyalist Winter Club accepts no responsibility for lost ice time due to any event beyond our control. No refunds will be provided in the event of such an occurrence.
- All Skaters are required to pay the Skate Canada Fee at registration (Unless already paid at another club).
- Any bursary amounts accumulated must be applied to the registration fees.

FAMILY DISCOUNT:

- FULL REGISTRATION (highest fees) for first family member
- 10% off Registration Fees for each additional family members

ELIGIBILITY

Skaters may register only for sessions for which they qualify. If a skater qualifies to advance to a higher level, a fee adjustment will occur. A Level Promotion Form must be submitted by the coach to the Executive. Should you feel your skater should register for a different session then they qualify, their coach is required to submit in writing the request to the board indicating the reason for the Level Promotion.

GUEST SKATING

Guest skating fees will be \$15 for LWC club members and \$20 for non-club members

Numbers will be limited to 20 StarSkaters on the ice during any one session. Skaters may only guest skate in current level registered. If you are unsure of qualified level, please contact by email for clarification. Guest skating will not be permitted two weeks prior to test days and certain competitions (to be determined). Check LWC calendar at www.loyalistwinterclub.org to verify availability for guest skating.

PROGRAM ASSISTANTS

Program Assistants (PA's) are volunteer skaters from our StarSkate Program. All PA's are required to attend a training clinic in September, date to be announced. These trained volunteers play an important part in the Canskate program, and can contribute greatly to the success of our programs. The role of the PA is to assist the Skate Canada Professional Coach.

CLUB COMPETITION

Club Competition will be held in January 29, 2010 at W.J. Henderson Arena. Skaters from Stage 2 and up are encouraged to participate. Skaters will have the opportunity to learn and practice solos prior to the competition as part of their lessons.

MARCH ICE SCHEDULE AND ANNUAL ICE SHOW
